




#### ABOUT BETHANN TELFORD & TEAM BT

She was recently honored by the National Brain Tumor Society by awarding a BethAnn Telford Chair in Systems Biology grant, which will support the University of Florida's project targeting application of complex adaptive system approach to managing tumor populations. She hopes her courage, spirit, and energy are truly an inspiration to all.
